Read this story in the Bible:

Luke 15 v 11-24

Jesus told another parable about a son who wanted to leave home. His father gave him some money and he went to another country. There he wasted all his money.

When he had no money left, there was a famine. No one gave him any food. He had to feed the pigs. He remembered his home and his kind father. He knew he had been very wrong.

The son made up his mind to return home and ask his father to take him back as a servant. He knew he didn't deserve to be a son any more.

But when his father saw him, he ran out and welcomed him. He forgave his son because he loved him so much.

God is like that. He is waiting for people like us to return to Him. We need to be truly sorry for not loving Him as we should, and for all the wrong things we have done, thought and said.

We can be forgiven because Jesus took all the punishment for our sin when He died. What a kind God we have! Pray to Him now.
