Read this story in the Bible: Luke 10 v 25-37

Jesus told this parable to show that being a Christian is not about keeping rules, but about our hearts. A man

was walking from Jerusalem to Jericho. It was a lonely road. On the way some bad men jumped out from behind some rocks and beat him up. Then they stole his money and left him lying in the road.

A bit later a priest came along. He saw the man and immediately crossed the road and passed by. He didn't want to get dirty by touching him!

Then another religious man walked by. He came and looked at the poor man, and then went on his way. No one was helping the poor man. How unkind!

But then a Samaritan man came along. He felt really sorry for the man. He bandaged up his wounds, and picked him up. He sat him on his own donkey and took him to an inn where he looked after him. He even paid the bill for the sick man. How kind!
