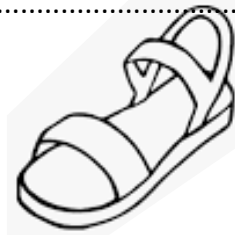


Ruth 4

Name



Redeemed!

To redeem means to buy back something or someone. Business deals like this were usually done at the city gate. It was a kind of official meeting place. In Ruth's time you sealed a deal by giving your sandal to the other person!

Kinsman means close relative.

Look at Ruth chapter 4



1. Boaz wanted to *sell some grain / marry Ruth*
2. Boaz asked the close relative if wanted to marry Ruth. He said (v 6):
Yes of course I will / No I can't - I will ruin my inheritance

The other man took off his sandal and gave it to Boaz. The deal was done. Many people witnessed it, so he couldn't change his mind.

3. Did Boaz marry Ruth? (v 13)

4. What name was given to the baby son that was born to Boaz and Ruth? (v 17)

Write his name in the box on the family tree underneath Boaz.

Read verse 17 again.

5. Obed had a son. What was his name?

Write his name in the box underneath Obed.

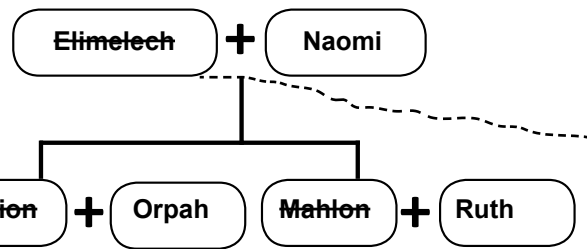
6. Jesse had a son too. What was his name?
