Have you been in that situation? Perhaps you are the only one in your class or group of friends who believes in God. The Lord promises to keep those who trust in Him.

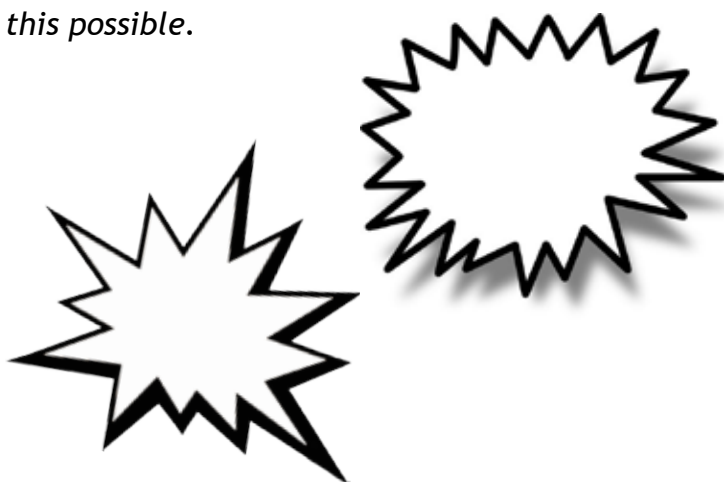
Look up Matthew 1 v 5. This is a list of the family line of the Lord Jesus. 6) Whose name is included in this verse?
