Ruth 4

Redeemed!



Read Ruth 4 v 1-6

To redeem means to buy back something or someone. Business deals like this were usually done at the city gate. It was a kind of official meeting place.

1. What thing belonging to Naomi did Boaz say needed to be redeemed? (v 3-4)



2. When Boaz explained that the close relative also had to marry Ruth, what did he say? (v 6) cross out the wrong words

Yes of course I will / No I can't - I will ruin my inheritance

3. Who was willing to redeem the land and marry Ruth?

Verse 7-8 explains an old Israelite custom which confirmed an exchange or redemption of goods.

4. What did the close relative take off and give to Boaz? (v 8) *Verses 9-12 tell us about the witnesses present. These people were respected men of the city. They saw what had happened and would back Boaz up if there was ever an argument about what he had done.*

5. What happened to Boaz and Ruth? (v 13)

6. What did the Lord give them? (v 13)

7. How did Naomi feel about being a grandmother at last, do you think?

Read verse 17.


8. What name was given to the baby?
