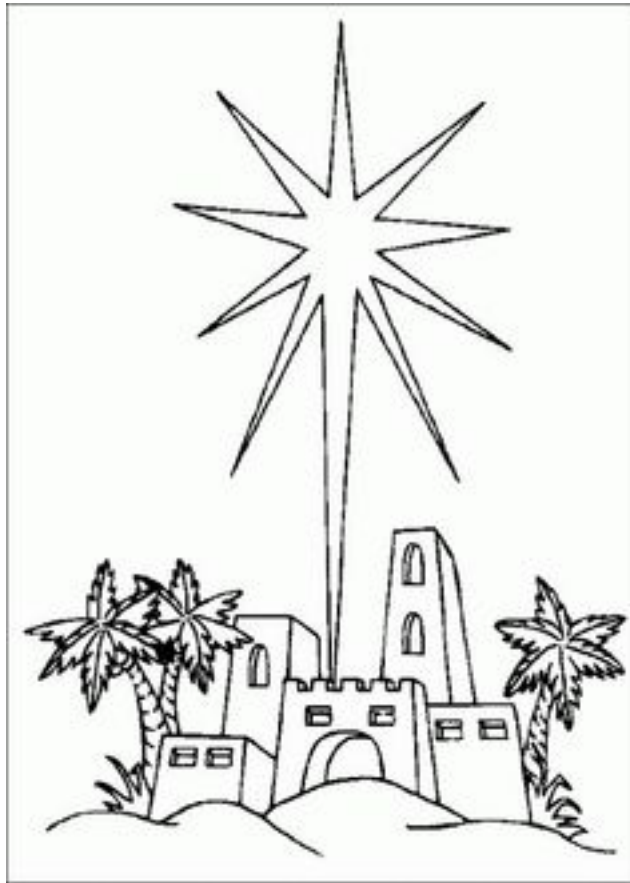

Isaiah 9 v 6. Isaiah told us that a Child would be born Who would be God and Man. These are some of the names He would be called. This is Jesus!

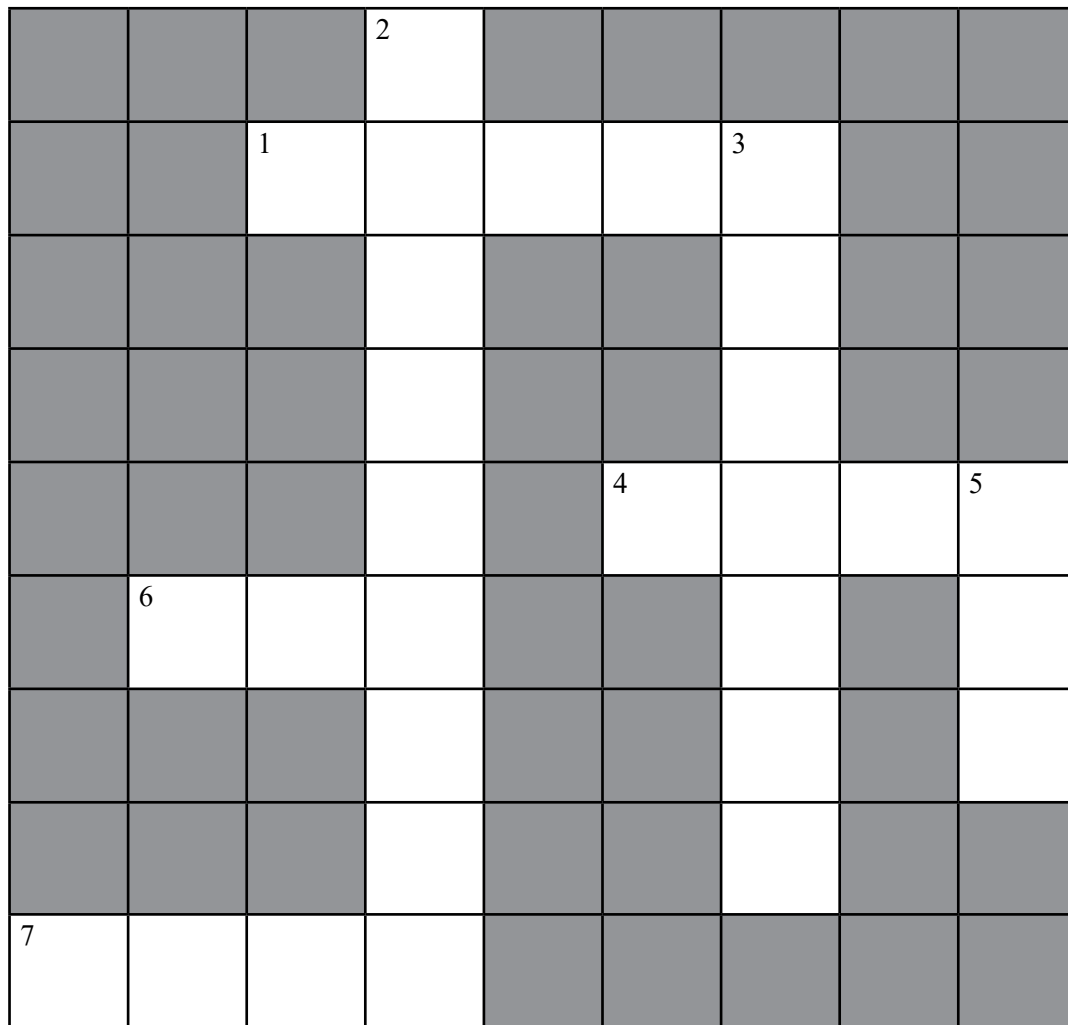
Micah 5 v 2. Micah told us where this Child would be born. It was in B..... He says this Child is from everlasting. This is Jesus!
