**Read Romans 6 v 23.** This introduces us to the subject for this week.

1) What are the wages of sin? ..... God has warned us where sin leads. We must take notice! But ...



2) What is the gift of God? .....

The person in today's lesson came face to face with death and all the horror and sorrow it brings with it. **Read Luke 7 v 11-16.**

3) Describe what happened .....



Think about this widow's situation. 4) How many children did she have? .....

*His death meant no family, probably no income, and no hope of future grandchildren. **Death brings sorrow and loneliness. We have seen this a lot in our country in the past weeks.***

5) Could anything be done for this man once death had struck him? .....

***Death is powerful. We don't know how this man died. He may have been strong and healthy but had met with an accident. Or he may have caught a deadly virus.***

*This speaks to us about our spiritual condition. We are dead to all spiritual things when we are born. We need the power of Jesus to bring us to spiritual life - to give us the gift of eternal life.*

### **What did Jesus do?**

*This event helps us to understand what God does when someone is converted.*

1) He **TOUCHED** the dead man's open coffin to make the procession stop. God touches a person's life to make them stop going down the wide road to destruction.

2) He **SPOKE** to the dead man. That was amazing! A dead person can't hear, but when God speaks to a person's soul He can make them hear, or understand their danger and also their helplessness to save themselves.

3) He **GAVE LIFE**. Only God can give a person spiritual life, new life. We call it being born again.

*Read verse 16 again. The people witnessing this miracle said, "God has visited His people." When someone is given new life, God is visiting them.*



**Has He visited you? Ask Him for faith to believe in Jesus, and to give you the gift of eternal life. Remember that it cost the Saviour His life to bring eternal life to sinners.**
