
MOUNT ZION BAPTIST CHURCH SUNDAY SCHOOL BULLETIN NO 15

We are rejoining the Children of Israel on their journey through the wilderness towards the Promised Land. God had provided the pillar of cloud and fire to guide them and daily food and water. 1) How much do you think God cared for His people? 2) How should the people have felt about God's kindness to them? They were now at Sinai. Moses had gone up the mountain to receive the Ten Commandments from God. The people were left waiting. Look at Exodus 32. 3) What did the people ask Aaron to do? (v1) 4) Did Aaron listen to them? (v2-4) 5) What do you feel about this? 6) How did the Lord feel about this unfaithfulness to Him? (v7-10) When the Lord sees us making other 'gods' for ourselves instead of Him, He feels just the same. 7) What other 'gods' might you have? Think of things that take up all your time, or thoughts. They could be anything that comes before God in your life: ••••• Moses prayed on behalf of the people that God would spare them, and He listened. Read verse 14. 8) When Moses reached the foot of the mountain, describe what he felt and did (v19-20) 9) What do you think of Aaron's poor excuse? (v22-24) Our Sin What the Israelites had done was a gross sin against the kind Lord God. But we have acted in just the same way! What has God given us? EFIL Can you think of more things? By putting other things first in our life, we turn our backs on the God Who made us, and worship idols. We can even make an idol of ourselves so we become selfish (what's good for me?), and unthankful. That's quite ugly, isn't it! The Bible tell us what we deserve if we live like this. Look up Romans 6 v 23: That is an eternal death, which we can never escape from. Think how dreadful that is! Sin is very costly. What might you be putting before God in your life? We have all sinned, so deserve to be blotted out of God's book of life. What can be done? Who did God send in mercy and kindness to us, to bear away the punishment for our sin?

Have you turned to Him for forgiveness? Don't leave it too late!

THE GOLDEN CALF



Read Exodus 32 v 1-14
